The generation gap, which refers to a broad difference between one generation and another, especially between young people and their parents, usually leads to numerous conflicts. Such family conflicts can seriously threaten the relationship between parents and children at times.

One common issue that drives conflicts is the clothes of teenagers. While most teens are keen on wearing fashionable clothes which try to catch up with the youth trends, a number of parents who value traditional clothes believe that those kinds of attire violate the rules and the norms of the society.
